PROTECTIVE DRIVING

Protective driving has become one of the most important and reliable services for dignitaries, celebrities, high-net-worth individuals and corporations throughout the world. Its aim is to reduce the risk of collision by anticipating dangerous situations despite adverse conditions or the mistakes of other road users and to increase the level of the passenger's personal protection while travelling by car. This is achieved through a combination of advanced technology systems, high-quality vehicle equipment and highly trained individuals.

Professional protective drivers are trained to fully control their vehicles and to choose the correct responses in emergency and dangerous situations whilst on the road. In order to safely and reliably transport passengers from a point A to a point B in various environments, a high-level of skills and knowledge is required.

Protective driving is also known as safe / secure transportation; it combines in-depth knowledge with a high level of skills in order to conduct advanced journey reconnaissance, identify alternative routes and develop emergency evacuation operations.





Our **PROTECTIVE DRIVING** TRAINING COURSE has been developed to increase road safety and driving risks awareness. It aims to enhance accident prevention skills for professional drivers working within a Close Protection Team as a Protective / Security Drivers. Our commitment is to raise the Protective Driving standards and ensure that all trainees are adequately equipped to face real-life situations.

Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive an internationally recognized Protective Driver qualification which has been approved by The Royal Society for the Prevention of Accidents from the United Kingdom and endorsed as entry level by The International Security Driver Association from the United States of America.





The PROTECTIVE DRIVING TRANSCOURSE is based on the Roadcraft, the System of Car Control and the ACPO Police Driver Training Programme. It has been designed to enhance the students protective driving skills, including; observation and situational awareness, risk mitigation, advanced journey planning, evasive driving, countersurveillance and convoy driving.

DELIVERY METHOD

The course is delivered over a three-day period including 24 hours of guided practical and theoretical learning. Students will undertake a programme based on 50% theoretical training and 50% open-road practical training to ensure the knowledge and skills acquired are applied correctly within a real-life context. Our course follows a 4:1 instructor/student ratio to ensure a student-centred learning experience. Our instructors will provide individual daily feedback to the students to enhance their learning experience in a tailored manner.

The **PROTECTIVE DRIVING** TRAINING COURSE assessment policy is based on multi-choice theoretical individual assessments and daily driving competency modules.

The passing mark for the theoretical assessment is set to a minimum of 80% over a 30-minute time exam. The competency modules will be graded at the end of the course as competent or not competent.

Both assessments, practical and theoretical, will have to be successful in order to receive the certification.




